This report is required by C.R.S. 1-45-108(2)(a)(I)(E). Please be advised that pursuant to the Colorado Constitution Article XXVIII, Section 10(2)(a):

"The appropriate officer shall impose a penalty of fifty dollars per day for each day that a statement or other information required to be filed pursuant to section 5, section 6, or section 7 of this article, or sections 1-45-108, 1-45-109 or 1-45-110, C.R.S., or any successor sections, is not filed by the close of business on the day due."

In addition Campaign and Political Finance Rule 5.11 states:

"If a required report is not filed by 11:59 PM on the due date for electronic filing, then the daily penalty imposed pursuant to Article XXVIII, Section 10(2)(a) shall begin on the day following the due date for reports filed manually. This rule is repealed effective January 1, 2007."

Therefore, your committee is assessed a fine of \$ **1150**. Any outstanding balance of the imposed penalty beyond 60 days will be sent to State Collections. Please be advised you may appeal this fine pursuant to the Colorado Constitution Article XXVIII, Section 10(2)(b):
